

BASEES Covid-19 policy and travel guidance

The safety of delegates is our highest priority. BASEES is committed to organising a safe and inclusive conference. We strongly advise all delegates to be fully vaccinated against Covid-19. This is for your own and everyone else's safety. We also strongly recommend all colleagues to undertake a lateral flow test before arrival at the college.

Face coverings

BASEES strongly recommends all delegates to wear face covering in all conference venues, unless covered by the following exemptions:

- Those who are unable to wear a face-covering for medical reasons
- When eating or drinking.

Travel To the UK / Testing

From the 11 February, UK government will neither require a pre-departure test nor a post arrival test for visitors that qualify as fully vaccinated. Under current regulation, all visitors to the UK have to complete a Passenger Locator Form before arrival in the UK. This can be done online at <https://www.gov.uk/provide-journey-contact-details-before-travel-uk> You can submit the form any time in the 48 hours before you arrive in the UK.

Travel from the UK / Testing

Please make sure to check the national travel restrictions and testing requirements for the destination of your return journey. All London airports have testing centres. There are also several test clinics in Cambridge which will offer lateral flow and PCR tests.
